The domain name system (DNS) is a unique decentralized structure of domain names (domains) at the top level domain.

Domain names are registered and managed by a central authority, which is generally the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN). The gTLDs are managed by the registry operator, which is usually the cTLD, using a first-come, first-served policy. Some domain names have few restrictions, while others have special requirements.
